But not until a more recent time, when the importance of the pudic nerve and its many changes in distribution resulting from changes in the cloaca to form the perineum were suggested, was I convinced of the great similarity of physiologic symptoms due to their anomalies, diseases and injuries, and now at the conclusion of this research, I find this thought crystallized into one more certain and enduring. Especial attention has been given to the pudic nerve, lymphatics, Glomus coccygea, coccyx, Cowper s and Bartholin glands, because they play a more important role in symptomatology than has ever been ascribed to them. With the exception of the Glomus and Coccyx, no form of treatment is considered throughout this work. I have quoted freely from many...



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
