Pouqueville, (Voyage dans la Grece, tome 5, ) I shall subjoin an abstract of it, as it presents a curious picture of the condition of Epirus in the fourteenth century. It is a chronicle from 1350 to 1400, and was evidently written by an ecclesiastic: -- Under the Emperor John Palaeologus, when the Turks were in possession of Smyrna, Ephesus, and Prusa, and ravaged the coasts of Thrace, when the Genoese conquered Chios, and the Franks of Navarre all the Peloponnesus except Monembasia and Lacedaemonia Ioannina was taken A. D. 1350, by Stephen Krai of the Triballi or Servians, who had previously invaded the lands of the Empire and seized upon the Grecian Vlakhia\*, the government of which he bestowed...
